

UNGA Resolution 2020 'Situation of human rights in the Autonomous Republic of Crimea and the city of Sevastopol, Ukraine'

Suggestions from the Crimean Human Rights Group on the COVID-19 challenges to human rights

Expresses its grave concern in absence of effective measures in preventing the spreading of COVID-19 in the Autonomous Republic of Crimea and the city of Sevastopol such as organization of public events and allowing citizens of the Russian Federation to enter the occupied Crimea and non-use of measures on preventing the spreading of COVID-19 infection in Crimean prisons and pre-trial detention centers in particular.

Urges the Russian Federation, as the occupying power to take effective preventive measures necessary to combat the spread of COVID-19 in the Autonomous Republic of Crimea and the city of Sevastopol and in Crimean prisons and pre-trial detention centers in particular.
